

Guillaume Marquis-Gravel, MD

Biography

Dr. Guillaume Marquis-Gravel is an interventional cardiologist and clinical scientist at the Montreal Heart Institute, and an assistant professor at Université de Montréal since 2020. He completed his medical training (MD), a Masters in Biomedical Sciences (M.Sc., with Honors), a residency in internal medicine, and a residency in adult cardiology (with Honors) at the Université de Montréal. He then completed a 1-year clinical fellowship in interventional cardiology at Duke University (Durham, NC, United States), followed by a 2-year clinical research fellowship at the Duke Clinical Research Institute. He is the primary author or a co-author of 57 peer-reviewed publications, including in the *Journal of the American College of Cardiology*, *Circulation*, and *JAMA Cardiology*, and of 4 book chapters.
