

## **Andrew T. Yan, MD, FRCPC, FACC, FSCMR**

### **Biography**

Dr. Andrew Yan received his medical degree and his postgraduate training in internal medicine and cardiology at the University of Toronto. As the recipient of a Canadian Institute of Health Research fellowship award, he completed a 2-year clinical research fellowship in cardiac magnetic resonance imaging (MRI) at the Brigham and Women's Hospital, Harvard Medical School, Boston, USA. He is a member of the Division of Cardiology at St. Michael's Hospital and is a Professor of Medicine at the University of Toronto. He was the recipient of the New Investigator Award from the Heart and Stroke Foundation, and his work has been supported by the Heart and Stroke Foundation and the Canadian Institutes of Health Research. His research interests include clinical registries and clinical trials, risk stratification and treatment patterns in acute coronary syndromes, and novel applications of cardiac MRI in clinical practice and research. He is cross-appointed to the Department of Medical Imaging at the University of Toronto.
